

Criteria for Assessing Learning Outcomes of Students in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology with a Course of Advanced Training and Retraining in the Discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology" on a 10-Point Scale

10 (Ten) points / Pass:

- Systematic, profound, and comprehensive knowledge of all sections of the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology," as well as key topics extending beyond it.
- Precise use of scientific obstetric and gynecological terminology; competent, logically sound presentation of answers; ability to make well-grounded conclusions and generalizations.
- Flawless command of instruments and techniques used in obstetric and gynecological practice, with the ability to employ them effectively in formulating and solving scientific and professional tasks.
- Demonstrated ability to independently and creatively resolve complex problems in non-standard situations.
- Thorough and in-depth mastery of both core and supplementary literature on obstetrics and gynecology.
- Ability to navigate freely among theories, concepts, and trends in obstetrics and gynecology, providing analytical assessment thereof, and to utilize scientific achievements from other disciplines.
- Creative and independent work during practical classes; active and creative participation in group discussions; high level of proficiency in completing assignments.

9 (Nine) points / Pass:

- Systematic, profound, and comprehensive knowledge of all sections of the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Precise use of scientific obstetric and gynecological terminology (including in a foreign language); competent, logically sound presentation of answers.
- Command of obstetric and gynecological instruments and techniques, with the ability to employ them effectively in formulating and solving scientific and professional tasks.

- Ability to independently and creatively resolve complex problems in non-standard situations within the framework of the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Full mastery of both core and supplementary literature recommended by the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Ability to navigate key theories, concepts, and trends in the studied discipline and provide analytical assessment thereof.
- Systematic, active, and independent work during practical classes; creative participation in group discussions; high level of proficiency in completing assignments.

8 (Eight) points / Pass:

- Systematic, profound, and comprehensive knowledge of all sections of the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology" pertaining to the questions posed, within the scope of the curriculum.
- Use of scientific obstetric and gynecological terminology; stylistically competent, logically sound presentation of answers; ability to make well-grounded conclusions.
- Command of obstetric and gynecological instruments and techniques (methods of comprehensive diagnosis and treatment of major obstetric and gynecological diseases, information technology techniques), with the ability to use them in formulating and solving scientific and professional tasks.
- Ability to independently resolve complex problems within the framework of the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Mastery of both core and supplementary literature recommended by the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Ability to navigate theories, concepts, and trends in the studied discipline and provide analytical assessment thereof.
- Active independent work during practical classes; systematic participation in group discussions; high level of proficiency in completing assignments.

7 (Seven) points / Pass:

- Systematic, profound, and comprehensive knowledge of all sections of the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."

- Use of scientific obstetric and gynecological terminology (including in a foreign language); competent, logically sound presentation of answers; ability to make well-grounded conclusions.
- Command of obstetric and gynecological instruments and techniques, with the ability to use them in formulating and solving scientific and professional tasks.
- Fluency in standard solutions within the framework of the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Mastery of both core and supplementary literature recommended by the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Ability to navigate key theories, concepts, and trends in the studied discipline and provide analytical assessment thereof.
- Independent work during practical classes; participation in group discussions; high level of proficiency in completing assignments.

6 (Six) points / Pass:

- Sufficiently comprehensive and systematic knowledge within the scope of the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Use of necessary scientific obstetric and gynecological terminology; competent, logically sound presentation of answers; ability to make well-grounded conclusions.
- Command of obstetric and gynecological instruments and techniques, with the ability to use them in solving academic and professional tasks.
- Ability to independently apply standard solutions within the framework of the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Mastery of the core literature recommended by the discipline's curriculum.
- Ability to navigate basic theories, concepts, and trends in the studied discipline and provide a comparative assessment thereof.
- Active independent work during practical classes; periodic participation in group discussions; high level of proficiency in completing assignments.

5 (Five) points / Pass:

- Sufficient knowledge within the scope of the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Use of scientific terminology; competent, logically sound presentation of answers; ability to draw conclusions.

- Command of obstetric and gynecological instruments and techniques, with the ability to use them in solving academic and professional tasks.
- Ability to independently apply standard solutions within the framework of the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Mastery of the core literature recommended by the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Ability to navigate basic theories, concepts, and trends in obstetrics and gynecology and provide a comparative assessment thereof.
- Independent work during practical classes; participation in group discussions; high level of proficiency in completing assignments.

4 (Four) points / Pass:

- Sufficient scope of knowledge within the BSMU curriculum for "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Mastery of the core literature recommended by the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Use of scientific terminology; logical presentation of answers; ability to draw conclusions without significant errors.
- Command of obstetric and gynecological instruments and techniques, with the ability to use them in solving standard (typical) tasks.
- Ability to solve standard (typical) tasks under the instructor's guidance.
- Ability to navigate key theories, concepts, and trends in the studied discipline and provide an assessment thereof.
- Work under the instructor's guidance during practical classes; acceptable level of proficiency in completing assignments.

3 (Three) points / Fail:

- Insufficiently comprehensive scope of knowledge within the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Knowledge of only a portion of the core literature recommended by the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Use of scientific terminology; presentation of answers containing significant logical errors.
- Poor command of obstetric and gynecological instruments and techniques; incompetence in solving standard (typical) tasks.
- Inability to navigate key theories, concepts, and trends in the studied discipline.

- Passivity during practical classes; low level of proficiency in completing assignments.

2 (Two) points / Fail:

- Fragmentary knowledge within the scope of the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Knowledge of only individual literary sources recommended by the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology."
- Inability to use the scientific terminology of the discipline; presence of gross logical errors in the answer.
- Passivity during practical classes; low level of proficiency in completing assignments.

1 (One) point / Fail:

- Lack of knowledge and competencies within the scope of the BSMU curriculum for the discipline "Obstetrics and Gynecology," or refusal to answer, or failure to appear for assessment without a valid reason.
