

**Educational and research assessment criteria of learning outcomes  
on the academic discipline “Pediatric Infectious Diseases”  
for subresidency in general medical practice  
the specialty 1 – 79 01 01 “General medicine”**

1. **Calculating final assessment, the following activities are taken into account:**
  - theoretical part: oral answers, participating in discussions;
  - test control: current and final;
  - practical part: ability of making decisions in different medical cases, practical skills in examination of patient, laboratory and instrumental diagnostic;
  - additional activity: essay, presentation, report
  
2. The **student's rating score** for work in semester corresponds to **the arithmetic average** of all educational and research activities specified in paragraph 1.
  
3. The credit for the discipline "Pediatric Infectious Diseases" will have those students who have **no absences of practical lessons and lectures**, taking into account the rating score for the discipline:  
for 6<sup>th</sup> year students of medical faculty - **7 or more points**
