

**Methodology for calculating the student's academic performance indicator
at the Department of Surgery and Transplantology with an advanced training and retraining
course**

A. Methodology for calculating the rating score

1. Monitored types of academic activity:
 - current academic performance in the department (average grade for two semesters);
 - assessment based on case history.
2. Weighting factors for the indicators:

Indicator (P_i)	Weighting factor (k_i)
Current academic performance in the department (P_1)	0,6(k_1)
Grade based on medical history (P_2)	0,4(k_2)

3. Formula for calculating a student's rating grade:

$$P_c = k_1 \times P_1 + k_2 \times P_2$$

where

P_1 is the arithmetic mean grade for the current academic performance indicator over two semesters,

P_2 is the grade based on case history,

k_1 and k_2 are the weighting factors for the indicators,

P_c is the student's rating grade over two semesters, calculated to hundredths of a digit.

B. The formula for calculating the exam grade for a course is:

$$R_e = K_1 \times P_c + K_2 \times O_e$$

R_e is the final exam grade for the course (an indicator of the student's academic and research performance),

K_i is the weighting factor for the indicator,

P_c is the student's rating grade for the semester's work, calculated to the nearest hundredth of a digit,

O_e is the grade received on the exam (differentiated credit test).

Weighting factors for indicators:

Indicator	Weighting factor (k_i)
Student's rating grade for the semester's work (P_c)	0,3(K_1)
Exam grade (differential credit) (O_e)	0,7(K_2)

*In case of unsatisfactory exam result, the rating grade for the course is not taken into account, and the **unsatisfactory grade** is entered on the examination report.*

*If the student's rating grade is at least **8 (eight) points** and the grade received on the exam exceeds the student's rating grade, the grade received on the **exam** is entered on the examination report.*

*When retaking an exam in a course, the **grade is entered on the examination report without taking into account the student's rating.***

The methodology was approved at a meeting of the Department of Surgery and Transplantology with the Advanced Training and Retraining Course (protocol No. 1, September 1, 2025).
