PHARMACOTHERAPY" For 5th YEAR STUDENTS FOR THE SPECIALTY
«PHARMACY» IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY
IN THE 2026/2027 ACADEMIC YEAR

To be admitted to the Intermediate attestation, a student must:

1. Attend all lectures and practical classes in the course. All missed practical classes and lectures for disrespectful reason must be worked off (the schedule and rules are posted in the electronic courseware and on the department website; lectures must be worked off in the form of handwritten reports of 3 A4 pages). All practical classes and lectures missed for a respectful reason must be worked off: if no more than 2 classes are missed, they must be worked off in the E-learning BSMU Platform on the relevant topic with all tests completed; if 3 or more classes are missed, they must be worked off during the work-off period (according to the work-off or consultation schedules).
2. Have a positive average grade (at least 4 points) of a class on the pharmacotherapy of diabetes mellitus (if this lesson is missed, regardless of the reason, the test must be completed during the work-off period).
3. Prepare and defend a report on the class topic.
4. Complete the "Final Controlling Test" in the E-learning BSMU Platform with a score of at least 60%.

The midterm assessment on clinical pharmacology consists of an exam that includes an oral response to questions on the exam ticket and a practical skill's case. The midterm assessment grade is based on the results of the oral response. Students receive a bonus of 1 point for participating in the department's research project. Approved at the department meeting on August 31, 2026, protocol No. 1.
