«PHARMACY» IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY
IN THE 2025/2026 ACADEMIC YEAR

To pass the intermediate attestation, a student must:

1. Attend all lectures and practical classes in the course. All missed practical classes and lectures for disrespectful reason must be worked off (the schedule and rules are posted in the electronic courseware and on the department website; lectures must be worked off in the form of handwritten reports of 3 A4 pages). All practical classes and lectures missed for a serious reason must be worked off in the electronic courseware on the relevant topic with all tests completed. If more than two classes are missed for a serious reason, an oral interview on the relevant topic with a lecturer is mandatory during the consultation on the academic discipline / on supervised lectures.

2. Have a positive average grade (at least 4 points) in classes on the clinical pharmacology of antiarrhythmic drugs and the clinical pharmacology of antibacterial drugs that affect bacterial cell wall synthesis.

3. Have a positive grade (at least 4 points) in informing patients about the safety of over-the-counter medications.

4. Have a positive grade (at least 4 points) in practical skills for providing first aid to patients with anaphylactic shock and asthma attacks.

5. Prepare and defend a report on the class topic.

6. Complete the "Final Controlling Test for Semester 8" in the electronic courseware with a score of at least 60%.

The intermediate attestation consists of an oral interview.
