

REGULATIONS ON CURRENT CONTROL AND INTERMEDIATE
ATTESTATION ON CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY FOR 5th YEAR
STUDENTS FOR THE SPECIALTY «DENTISTRY» IN THE DEPARTMENT
OF CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY

To pass the midterm assessment, a student must:

1. Attend all lectures and practical classes in the course. All missed practical classes and lectures for disrespectful reason must be worked off (the schedule and rules are posted in the online electronic courseware and on the department website).
2. Maintain a passing average grade for the semester (at least 4 points).
3. Complete the "Final knowledge control test" in the electronic courseware with a score of at least 60%.
4. Have a passing score (at least 4 points) in completing the suspected adverse drug reaction reporting form.
6. Have a passing score (at least 4 points) in the practical skill: informing patients about the effects of medications, administration instructions, and possible adverse reactions.
7. Prepare and defend a report on the class topic.

The midterm assessment consists of an oral interview.
