The exam in Microbiology, Virology, Immunology is organized in 2 steps:

1. Practical skills exam (2 skills in the card)
2. Theoretical exam (4 questions in the card)

Students are allowed to take the theoretical exam if they have successfully passed the 1st stage (practical skills passed with a grade of "4" or higher).

Student rating:

- Formula for calculating a student's rating: $\text{Rating} = \text{Average score} * 0.3 + \text{Average colloquial score} * 0.7$
- Formula for calculating the final grade in the exam:
 $\text{Score} = \text{Rating} * 0.3 + \text{Practical skills} * 0.1 + \text{Oral answer} * 0.6 + \text{Bonuses (research work)}$
- If the student's rating is ≥ 7.0 and the grade for the oral exam is "7" or higher, the final grade is not calculated using the formula; instead, the grade for the oral answer on the theoretical exam is assigned
