

## **LECTURE NOTES CONTENT REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DISCIPLINE "MICROBIOLOGY, VIROLOGY, IMMUNOLOGY"**

Lecture notes must be written neatly and legibly, with the material organized into conceptual blocks. Key sections should be highlighted with indents, indented lines, or in color. It is advisable to include figures and diagrams relevant to the topic. Each lecture note must be signed with the student's full name and group number.

Lecture notes must include:

- 1) The date of the lecture, the number, and the title of the lecture topic;
- 2) List of the main sections of the lecture topic;
- 3) Key concepts and terms for each section, as well as the essence of the section.

Lecture notes for the sections "Special Bacteriology" and "Virology" should reflect the following:

- The role of the pathogen in human pathology;
- The systematic position of the pathogen;
- The morphology of the pathogen, general characteristics;
- The pathogenesis of infection;
- Anti-infective immunity;
- Principles of diagnosis and etiotropic therapy;
- Specific prevention.

Notes must be submitted **in handwritten form on white A4 paper**, with a **minimum of 5 pages** per lecture.
