- ✓ insufficient knowledge of basic microscope techniques;
- ✓ assimilation of part of the basic literature;
- ✓ inability to navigate the basic theories, concepts and directions in the subject of “pathological anatomy”;
- ✓ low level of task performance.

2 POINTS – UNSATISFACTORY (FAIL):

- ✓ fragmentary knowledge in accordance with the requirements of the program for the subject "pathological anatomy";
- ✓ ignorance or incorrect use of scientific terminology;
- ✓ incorrect diagnosis (with leading questions from the teacher) of the main general pathological processes and diseases based on macro- and micropreparations and at autopsy;
- ✓ incorrect diagnosis (with leading questions from the teacher) of the main general pathological processes and diseases based on the description of macro- and microscopic changes in organs and tissues of the body;
- ✓ lack of skills in using a microscope;
- ✓ assimilation of part or non-assimilation of the main literature;
- ✓ inability to navigate the basic theories, concepts and directions in the subject of “pathological anatomy”;
- ✓ low level of task performance.

1 POINT – UNSATISFACTORY (FAIL):

- ✓ lack of knowledge and competence in accordance with the requirements of the program for the subject "pathological anatomy" or refusal to answer.
