Total hours: 108 academic hours

1. Core areas of professional activity of a general practitioner (GP) and their team. Main medical documentation.
2. Temporary disability evaluation. Functions of the Medical Consultation Committee. Concept of the Medical Rehabilitation and Disability Evaluation Board.
3. Acute respiratory infections, acute tonsillitis. Emergency medical care for hyperthermia.
4. Acute bronchitis and pneumonia.
5. Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and bronchial asthma. Emergency medical care for an acute asthma attack. Differential diagnosis of broncho-obstructive syndrome.
6. Primary and secondary arterial hypertension, somatoform autonomic dysfunction. Emergency medical care for a hypertensive crisis.
7. Ischaemic heart disease. Angina pectoris, rhythm and conduction disorders. Emergency medical care for an anginal attack, acute coronary syndrome, cardiac asthma attack, pulmonary oedema, and acute arrhythmias.
8. Non-coronary heart diseases. Differential diagnosis of chest pain.
