Total hours: 108 academic hours

1. Functional dyspepsia, chronic gastritis, gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD), gastric and duodenal peptic ulcer disease. Emergency medical care for suspected gastrointestinal bleeding.
2. Functional biliary disorders, chronic cholecystitis, chronic pancreatitis. Emergency medical care for biliary colic.
3. Non-infectious inflammatory bowel disease (IBD), irritable bowel syndrome (IBS). Differential diagnosis of dyspepsia and abdominal pain syndrome.
4. Chronic hepatitis and liver cirrhosis. Differential diagnosis of jaundice and hepatosplenomegaly.
5. Chronic pyelonephritis, chronic glomerulonephritis, chronic kidney disease (CKD). Emergency medical care for renal colic. Differential diagnosis of urinary syndrome.
6. Iron deficiency anemia, vitamin B12 deficiency anemia, and folate deficiency anemia. Differential diagnosis of anemia.
7. Clinical management of patients with type 2 diabetes mellitus, medical prevention of complications. Diabetic comas (hyperglycemic and hypoglycemic). Differential diagnosis of conditions presenting with loss of consciousness (syncope, collapse).
