

**REQUIREMENTS FOR THE INTERMEDIATE ASSESSMENT  
(ADMISSION TO THE EXAM)  
DISCIPLINE "PROPAEDEUTICS OF INTERNAL DISEASES"  
3<sup>rd</sup> YEAR STUDENTS OF THE GENERAL MEDICINE FACULTY  
IN 2025/2026 ACADEMIC YEAR**

To be allowed to take an exam student should:

1. Attend all lectures and practical classes on the discipline. All missed practical classes and lectures must be reworked (schedule and rules are posted on the e-test);
2. Have the credits in the discipline "Propaedeutics of Internal Diseases" for 4th and 5th semesters;
3. Have a positive average grade for the semester (at least 4 points). To increase average grade student can rework practical classes in which he/she received unsatisfactory grades (with payment);
4. Turn in educational case history (the teacher checks it and puts a signature on it);
5. Complete the workbook "Diagnostic methods in the internal medicine" (the teacher checks it and puts a signature on it);
6. Pass the Final online test with a result of at least 40%.
7. Pass the practical skills test by checklists with a mark of at least 4 points.

**If the requirements are not completed, the student is not allowed to take the exam.**

**If you miss more than 50% of lectures in the 3rd year of a subject "Propaedeutics of Internal Diseases", your exam grade will be reduced by 1 point.**
