 14. Early diagnosis of dementia. Active lifestyle as prevention and mental hygiene of dementia. The role of rational nutrition in the prevention of dementia. Cognitive function training. Technologies for caring for patients with dementia.
 15. Classification and mechanism of action of psychoactive drug. Clinical epidemiology of psychoactive drug use.
 16. Substance addiction syndrome. Biopsychosocial mechanisms of addiction to psychoactive substances. Altered reactivity syndrome. Syndromes of mental and physical dependence.
 17. Measures to prevent drunkenness and addiction to psychoactive substances.
 18. Schizophrenia: epidemiology, etiology, pathogenesis, classification, principles of systematics.
 19. Forms of schizophrenia. Types of schizophrenia. Prevention of exacerbations and disability in schizophrenia.
 20. Mood Disorders: clinical phenomenology, taxonomy and classification.
 21. Neurotic and stress-related disorders: clinical phenomenology, taxonomy and classification.
