

**OBJECTS OF CONTROL AND ASSESSMENT CRITERIA FOR THE  
CREDIT IN RUSSIAN AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE**

**I SEMESTER**

**(for students of English-speaking groups in the specialties "General  
Medicine", "Dentistry", "Pharmacy")**

**1. Scale for assessing the development of oral monologue speech skills.**

The development of oral monologue skills and the ability to answer questions on a given topic are monitored.

**Scale for assessing the development of monologue speech skills**

<b>Mark</b>	<b>Indicators for assessing the results of educational activities</b>
10 (ten) points, passed	The oral monologue is coherent, logical, and consistent. The topic is fully covered. There are no grammatical, lexical, or other errors.
9 (nine) points passed	The oral monologue is logical, coherent, and consistent. The topic is fully covered. One or two grammatical or lexical errors are permitted.
8 (eight) points passed	The oral monologue is logical, coherent, and consistent. The topic is fully covered. One or two grammatical and one or two lexical errors are permitted.
7 (seven) points passed	The oral monologue is logical, coherent, and consistent. The topic is fully covered. Two to three grammatical and/or two to three lexical errors are permitted.
6 (six) points passed	The oral monologue is logical, coherent, and consistent. The topic is fully covered. Three to four grammatical and two to three lexical errors are permitted.
5 (five) points passed	The oral monologue is logical and coherent. There are some irregularities in the flow of presentation. The topic is not fully explored. Four to five grammatical and three to four lexical errors are permitted.
4 (four) points passed	The oral monologue is logical and coherent. There are some irregularities in the flow of presentation. The topic is not fully explored. Five to six grammatical and three to four lexical errors are permitted.
3 (three) points failed	The oral monologue is inconsistent and lacks coherence. The topic is not fully explored. More than 6-7 grammatical and 5-6 lexical errors were made.
2 (two) points failed	The oral statement contains serious violations of grammatical and syntactic norms. More than eight grammatical and seven lexical errors were made, making the statement difficult to understand.
1 (one) point failed	The student is unable to make an oral presentation on the proposed topic.

**2. Written Language Skills Assessment Scale (Grammar Task)**

Reading and text comprehension skills, as well as written language skills are tested.

### **Evaluation criteria**

The maximum score is 10 points.

The maximum score for a grammar task is 10 points; Task 1 – 4 points, Task 2 – 4 points, Task 3 – 2 points. Each grammatical error reduces the score by 1 point.
