

Note: The final grade for the discipline is formed from:
0.4 rating grade for the academic year + 0.6 marks on the exam.

In order to encourage a responsible attitude of students to study, increase the degree of motivation of students, начисляются **penalty points** are awarded for:

- skipping lectures without a valid excuse - 0.3 fine. unit;
- missing practical classes without a good reason - 0.3 fine. unit;
- untimely working off of missed classes - 0.5 fine. unit;
- untimely delivery of final lessons - 0.5 fine. unit.

* **Working off missed classes and lectures is carried out in accordance with Regulation No. 264on working off training sessions.**

In order to stimulate the educational and research work of students, bonus points are awarded for:

- presentation with an essay in class - 0.2;
- presentation of an abstract at a meeting of the Council of People's Commissars - 0.5;
- presentation of a report at the studio. scientific conference without a prize - 0.6;
- presentation of a report at the studio. scientific conference with a prize - 0.8;
- winner at the Republican review-competition (3rd and 2nd category) - 0.9;
- winner at the Republican review competition (1 category, laureate) - 1.0;
- * when speaking on one topic, bonus points are not summed up, a higher score is chosen
- publication in a collection of scientific papers, abstracts - 0.3;
- publication of a journal article - 0.5;

□ preparation of visual aids, educational and museum preparations from 0.2 - 0.5 (by the decision of the department).

* **The bonus point can not exceed 1 in total.**

At the end of the 8th semester, before the start of the examination session, each student in the "Journal of accounting for attendance of practical classes, current student performance, exam results" is given a rating score based on the results of the academic year, which consists of the results of current performance (Table 1,2,3), the presence of penalty points (deducted from the rating score), bonus points.

Final examination score for the discipline (an indicator of the student's academic and research activities) it is calculated using the formula (see. table 3-4):

$$R_y = P_s \cdot 0,4 + About_e \cdot 0,6$$

R_y - final exam score for the discipline

P_s— student's rating score for work in semesters 7,8

0,4 – coefficient of weight of the indicator (educational and research work)

About_e— score obtained on the exam

0,6 - coefficient of weight показателя of the exam score indicator.
