**Requirements for the admission to exam (2nd semester) on discipline
“Pathological anatomy”**

1. Credit for the 1st semester.
2. Attendance of all the practical classes and lectures with completion of all academic detention sessions (both with and without reasonable excuse for practical classes and only without reasonable excuse for lectures).
3. Practical skills acquirement during classes, accompanied by completion of all microscopic drawings in albums for all the topics with final mark for the album (both semesters).
4. Positive marks for practical skills “Gross- and micropreparations diagnostic”.
 - 4.1 The level of practical skills is generally (but not obligatory) evaluated by teacher who haven't trained the group;
 - 4.2 The level of practical skills on gross- and micropreparations diagnostic is evaluated separately;
 - 4.3 Retake is available only for the part of credit, which was evaluated less than 4 (“four”), i.e. on gross- and/or micropreparations.
