

## REQUIREMENTS

for intermediate certification in the discipline “General Hygiene”  
2nd year students of the Faculty of Medicine for foreign students  
specialty "General Medicine".

Interim certification in the discipline “General Hygiene” is carried out at the end of the 4th semester in the form of a **differential pass**, taking into account the rating assessment of the student’s educational and research activities.

**Differential testing** in the discipline “General Hygiene” is carried out in **oral and written form** in accordance with the testing schedule

- **subject to successful completion of the current certification** (working off all missed lectures, practical classes, unsatisfactory grades in final classes and practicing practical skills);

- **availability of practical training protocols.**

**The final grade** in the discipline “General Hygiene” (which is entered in the grade book and examination transcript) is formed taking into account the results of the current academic performance in the semester, the grade for mastery of practical skills and the grade obtained during the examination according to the formula:

$$P = \text{Recz} * 0.6 + \text{Rakad} * 0.2 + \text{Rprak} * 0.2;$$

where P - is the final grade in the discipline;

Recz – assessment obtained during differential testing;

Rakad – includes current performance in practical classes and grades on final papers for semesters 3 and 4;

Rprak - includes an average mark for mastery of practical skills.

**Admission to differential testing** is carried out at the last practical lesson in the form of:

- **computer testing** (provided that the average score for the semester is 5 or higher);

- **computer testing and oral questioning**, if the average score for the semester is below 5 or in case of receiving an unsatisfactory grade based on the test results.
